A. Introduction

Zoe Nicolaou is an Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon. She specialized in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery in Rabin Medical Center of Tel-Aviv University- Israel and she received the title of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon in 2000. Dr. Nicolaou joined the Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Clinic in Athens as a Postgraduate Fellow for 2 years after graduating from the Dental School of Athens University in 1992, “first in class” and she recited the oath at the graduation ceremony receiving the reward of Colgate Palmolive. Dr. Zoe Nicolaou has three beautiful children.

She has a special interest in Orthognathic Surgery and individuals with cranio-facial syndromes and facial deformities. This is why she cooperates with the Cyprus Center for Clefts & Facial Deformities (MEDICLEFT), where a team of specialists monitor and treat patients with similar problems. Dr. Nicolaou has been practicing Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery in Limassol, Cyprus since 2000 and she is a Ph.D. candidate at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki with the proposed subject “MMA in treating OSAS. Correlation of the objective measurements of upper airway with the PSG results”.

In 2014 she founded the Cyprus Association of Oral and Maxillo Facial Surgery (CYAOMS). In November 2014 she was elected as Vice President of the International College of Maxillo Facial Surgery (ICMFS) and in 2022, as President-Elect for 2025. In addition, Dr. Zoe Nicolaou hosted in 2015 the 29th World Congress of the ICMFS in her hometown, Limassol, (www.icmfs2015.com) and in 2023 she preceded the first Mediterranean Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery Congress 2023 (MEDomfs23) with the title ‘Digital Evolution in Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery’ (www.medomfs23.com). The MEDomfs23 congress which was organized by the Cyprus Association of Oral and Maxillo Facial Surgery (CYAOMS) is now a franchised congress that will carry on and be held by other Mediterranean nations.

Furthermore, Dr. Zoe Nicolaou has served as councilor of the Republic of Cyprus at the International Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons (IAOMS) since 2017 and she is an active member of the European Association of Cranio-Maxillofacial Surgery (EACMFS). The 29th World Congress of the International College for Maxillofacial Surgery aimed to create a meeting point for Maxillofacial Surgeons, researchers, scientists, academics and professionals in related areas from all over the world to facilitate this scientific community to share its

experiences amongst each other as well as to provide learning and discussion in relation to the latest scientific achievements in this specialized area. The ulterior motive of the Congress was none other than the improvement of patient care and the attainment of a better quality of life.

The ICMFS 2015 scientific program overall provided excellent opportunities to exchange ideas and expand visions.

Dr Zoe Nicolaou - Congress President, along with the Cyprus Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, organized in Limassol, Cyprus the 1st Mediterranean Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery Congress 2023 (MEDomfs23) between 27-29 September 2023. (www.medomfs23.com).

The 1st MEDomfs23 introduced an innovative congress focused on new technologies and digital evolutions in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. The scientific program of the congress was rich and brought to the foreground topics that were not presented in OMFS conferences before. Applications of digital technologies were presented perhaps for the first time and the congress attained a very important goal; to attract as many young scientists as possible.

The Congress encouraged the participation of oral and maxillofacial surgeons, dentists, plastic surgeons, ENTs, nurses, other health professionals, researchers, scientists, and academics in an

effort to generate added value to the field of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and extend the influence of Cyprus and of the wider region at a European and global level.

The scientific committee of the conference consisted of members from several National OMFS Associations. More specifically, two members from the National Associations of Cyprus, Greece, Israel, Italy, Spain, and Serbia were assigned with the role of evaluating the submitted abstracts, assisting in the development of the scientific program, and planning their Guest Society sessions.

The MEDomfs23 was placed under the auspices of the Cyprus Ministry of Health and the European Association for Cranio-Maxillofacial Surgery (EACMFS). Also, the International Association of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons (IAOMS) supported the conference and collaborated with the EACMFS in delivering a joint symposium called “IAOMS Next-Gen EACMF Symposium” which challenged both junior and senior Oral and Maxillofacial surgeons in debating around trending OMFS topics.

The scientific program of the Congress included 4 Guest Society Associations, 25 Keynote Lecture Sessions, 1 Symposium, more than 50 oral presentations, 5 Masterclasses, given by renowned experts, 5 workshops, innovative and interactive E-poster presentation sessions with nearly 50 posters and more.
